The missing package manager for macOS

Why use a package manager?

Homebrew installs the stuff you need that Apple didn't.

- Install UNIX tools, macOS apps and even fonts
- · Reproducible configurations stored as code
- Easily automate environment setup
- · Trivial updates: brew outdated; brew upgrade

What's the difference?

- · Homebrew downloads the latest version of the toolkit
- · Installs it in a subfolder of the local package Cellar
- Symlinks command to /usr/local/bin/dita
- Runs anywhere without \$PATH fiddling
- No Windows baggage
